Minutes of April 17, 2013 meeting

### **Members present**

### **Old Business**

- ▲ Selectmen and Budget Committee hope to submit a warrant article at town meeting to get funding approval for construction work at South Gouldsboro. A public hearing to consider the options will be held May 23.
- ▲ We discussed future improvements that are needed at Prospect Harbor. They include a boat landing, additional parking space and another float. These projects are on hold because the South Gouldsboro work is more urgent.
- ▲ Near term improvements at Prospect Harbor involve removal of a derelict boat, an old lobster car and an abandoned float. Assistance from the Harbormaster may be required for these. A damaged piling needs to be repaired as well.

### **New Business**

- ▲ The Town Manager requested an update of our 5-Year Plan which identifies desirable future projects. The revised plan was drafted and will be submitted.
- ▲ Maine Division of Parks and Public Lands is accepting grant proposals for FY2014. Their guidelines favor recreational boating facilities rather than those for commercial fishing. Therefore, this is deemed unsuitable for our needs.
