Hog Island: Opens- 7/1/17 Closes- 12/31/17

Jones Cove: Opens- 7/1/17 Closes- 12/31/17

Deep Cove: Opens - 7/1/17 Closes-12/31/17

Joy Bay: Closes-9/30/17 Opens-4/30/18

Schieffelin Point (John Small Cove): Opens-7/1/17 Closes-12/31/17

Gouldsboro Bay (Point Francis- Sampson Point): Closes-6/30/17 Opens-1/1/18

Schieffelin Point (Bunker Cove): Opens-7/1/17 Closes-12/31/17

Birch Harbor: Opens-1/1/18 Closes-4/30/18

South Gouldsboro (Stave Island): Opens-1/1/18 Closes-6/30/17

Stave Island Bar: Opens-1/1/18 Closes-4/1/18
